As dedicated workers, it is absolutely essential that we have a voice in our jobs, including the ability to negotiate for better wages, benefits, staffing and working conditions.

SEIU 1107 members won a historic union contract which includes a 13.75% raise over three years and other wage increases. We believe we deserve the same seat at the table to gain urgent improvements. In today's uncertain economy and healthcare industry, we can't afford to be alone without union protections. Why is management often opposed to their employees having a union voice?

Without a union, management has all the decision-making power and workers have zero say. When workers form a union, we sit down with management and negotiate a written contract with job improvements. In other words, joining a union means that healthcare workers have a real seat at the table and that can be hard for management to accept at first. But SEIU members have shown that once we win our union, we can have a relationship with management based on mutual respect.
